SMALL GROUP LEADERS

<u>Description:</u>

The role of the Small Group Leaders is to lead our community in weekly small gatherings where students can discuss and grow deeper in their faith. These may be based on Scripture, spiritual reading, or third-party Bible studies (e.g. those published by Evangelical Catholic or FOCUS). Small group leaders accompany their small groupees spiritually, pray for them, and foster community and fellowship among those who come to their small group.

<u>Duties:</u>

- 1. Small Groups
 - a. Prepare for each week's small group by studying the material, planning good questions, and preparing an icebreaker and snack for the group (as applicable)
 - b. Intentionally reach out to each small group member to form holy friendships outside of small group
 - c. Pray for your small group members
- 2. Administration
 - a. Attend small group leader training at the beginning of each semester
 - b. Attend small group leader meetings regularly unless significant circumstances intervene
 - c. Work with the Faith Formation Chair to:
 - i. Establish the small group schedule for the semester
 - ii. Choose the material that will be worked through
 - Organize small group sign-ups by: designing/printing small group sign-ups; announcing small groups at Mass; contacting those interested in participating in a small group and connecting them with a leader
 - d. Advocate for small groups within the ministry and actively invite people into your small group
